

# Adult Bible Fellowship • Teacher

## Objective

It is the objective of the Sunday School teacher to endeavor to bring those under their instruction to a level of spiritual maturity and understanding by consistently teaching them the principles of God's Word and providing an example that they can follow. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 – "All scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works."

## Responsibilities

1. (Optional) Attend the Worker's Meeting every Sunday morning from 9:00-9:10 a.m. in the library to have prayer with the Superintendent.
2. Be in the classroom by 9:15 a.m. each Sunday morning in time to welcome members and meet all guests.
3. Give considerable time to the preparation of the lesson each week. The best method is:
  - Read the passage and lesson – Monday/Tuesday
  - Attend the teacher's meeting on Wednesday or listen to the audio lesson supplement on Wednesday/Thursday.
  - Final development of the lesson – Friday/Saturday
  - Teach the lesson – Sunday
4. Teach the lesson each week. Begin concluding the lesson by 10:20. Make certain the Sunday School class is concluded at 10:25.
5. Check the classroom before leaving, making certain everything is in its proper place (e.g., all paper picked up, etc.).
6. Secure a replacement for your class/table and notify the Department Director of the replacement if you are ill or will be out of town.
7. Be enthusiastic in participation in all fellowship time ministries.
