1.	God requires(8b). The seventh	
	day is set aside for Holy Pursuits.	
2.	God requires for six days (v. 9)	
	followed by rest on the seventh day. We dare not overlook our	
	Lord's intent for the first six days simply because we are faithful to	
	the seventh!	
3.	God requires on the seventh day (v. 10).	
	Unlike the first six days which are given to work, the seventh is to be	
	given to rest and to worship. (The Hebrew word "Sabbath" means,	
	"rest." The seventh day is properly called a day of rest.)

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- 1. The pattern set by God (v. 11a). Our omnipotent God never tires (Ps. 121:4). In kindness, He established a pattern to meet our needs (Mk. 2:27). God knows our need for rest (Ps. 3-4).

BE CAREFUL IN YOUR UPHOLDING
The Fourth Commandment provokes many oft-repeated questions. Let's onsider them as we consider how to best uphold the "Day of Rest."
S THIS "REST DAY" FOR? There are those who will say, "This is the Old Testament's teaching!" Some will say, "This is the Jewish Law and I'm not bound by it!" Let's take a moment to offer an answer:
<ol> <li>Consider the other commandments. Are we bound by them?</li> <li>The Fourth Commandment pre-dates the God instituted the Day of Rest before man sinned (Gen. 2:2).</li> <li>God knows of our need for That need did not change with the coming of the Church Age.
